


Pre-carving design for the Lermans' Pumpkin

**Question:** My cousin took some impressive pictures of a place called Petra in the country, Jordan. What is the history behind it?

Aaron's Answer (A'sA): Petra is a city in modern-day Jordan, and it was the capital of the kingdom of the Nabataeans during the Hellenistic and Roman eras. It is now in ruins, but it is still a major tourist spot. The city existed well before the Nabataeans found it, but it was only populated by a few farming communities before the Nabataeans arrived. During the age of Moses, the region was ruled by five kings, who were named Evi, Rekem, Zur, Hur, and Reba.
