Status of Covid-19

Increases in cases led to the reinstatement of a county-wide indoor-masking county-wide recommendation on July 16th:

As of July 22nd, Foster City had **807** cases, up 20 from June's **787** cases, which had been up only 4 from May's **783**. In the prior nine months the case Counts for the months April '21 through Aug '20 were: **763**, **744**, **708**, **646**, **436**, **174**, **145**, **122**, and **67**.

Our county stood at 43,676 cases, up more than 1200 from June's 42,386, which had been up only 317 from May's 42,069. 41,013; 40,105; 38,674; 35,235; 23,681; 13,707; 11,341; 9,785; and 8,000 were the case counts in the nine months prior to May, 2021.
