## Aaron's Answers

Question: What is a "tidal basin"? I've heard that term before and assumed it has to do with a coastline. Is it a general kind of landform, a specific place (in which case - where is it?), or is it both?

Aaron's Answer: A tidal basin is a type of landform. It's essentially like a bay but because it is cut off from the ocean or other bodies of water, it is only accessible during high tide, because that's when the water is high enough that boats can make it over the divide separating the basin from the other body of water. It can be anywhere near another body of water and it can be man-made or natural.

Editor's additional note: The expression is also used as a proper noun, as I found this about one near our nation's capital:

The **Tidal Basin** is a man-made reservoir located between the Potomac River and the Washington Channel in Washington, D.C. It is part of West Potomac Park, is near the National Mall and is a focal point of the National Cherry Blossom Festival held each spring.
