Aaron's Answer (A'sA): There is indeed a process for new sports being introduced into the Olympics! First, national committees or countries can propose a new sport to be included. The International Olympic Committee (IOC) then evaluates it through the Program Commission.

The Program Commission makes a recommendation (whether to include or not include the new sport) to the IOC Session, an assembly of the IOC members, influential figures in sports, politics and business. After a vote in the IOC Session, the new sport is either added or denied addition to the Olympics.

New sports have been added to the Olympics recently. During the 2020 Tokyo Summer Olympics, 3 new sports: skateboarding, sport climbing (like rock climbing) and surfing were added to the Olympics. None of them have been removed as of yet. This year saw a new sport as well: Olympic Breaking. Also known as breakdancing, two people went into an arena together to dance to music with the hip-hop dance style, breakdancing. Neither person would know what music would be played ahead of time. Despite many countries participating in it, breakdancing was unpopular compared to other sports, and there was backlash from the modern pop culture community, since making breakdancing a sport or competition was seen as antithetical to the spirit of the dance. It has been said that Olympic Breaking will not return to the Olympics in 2028.

Multiple sports have been removed or not added to the Olympics. In the history of the modern Olympics, these 10 sports have been added completely and then removed: croquet, cricket, Jeu de Paume, pelota, polo, roque, rackets, tug-of-war, lacrosse and motor boating. For those who don't know, Jeu de Paume is sort of like tennis, pelota is similar and roque is like croquet. Three sports featured in the 2020 Olympics will also not be returning in 2024: Karate, softball and baseball. All of them were deemed unable to attract a younger audience to the Olympics, and removed.

A final interesting sport, Wushu (Chinese Martial Arts) was in the 1936 and 2008 Summer Olympics as an exhibition. In 1936, it was specifically requested to appear by Chancellor Hitler, however the Olympic Committee was not

impressed enough to include it in future games. This has caused many nations in South-East Asia to invest into the SEA Games, an Asian version of the Olympics where many sports not played in the Western Olympics are played. In general, many nations only really invest into a few sports their people enjoy and prefer to play more local games.
